How to use CloudMe



This tutorial will teach you the idea of the service, basic structure of the CloudMe apps, our naming conventions and give you some ideas of how you can make the most of the CloudMe service.

Your safety and privacy is our top priority. That is why CloudMe is located within the European Union in Sweden – a neutral country known for its strong privacy laws and legal system. We also operate and own our servers. Simply, we created a service we use and trust with our own files.

CLOUD STORAGE AND BEYOND

CloudMe provides cloud storage through the blue CloudMe folder (available on all your devices), additional synced folders, and a cloud drive that enables you to store anything in the cloud without keeping it synced to a computer. This enables you to make full use of CloudMe with only a browser and no connected computers, through its mobile applications alone or as a combination with computers, phones, and TV apps. Many competing solutions make no sense to use if you do not connect a computer, they sync one folder and does not allow you to create folders in the cloud that are not synced to a computer. Such services are somewhat easier to use, but the drawback is that everything you put in the cloud will end up on all your devices. With CloudMe you choose what to sync to each device, allowing you to use CloudMe as an extended hard drive for a computer with limited space, and avoid getting all your personal stuff on your work computer.

WE ARE ON MOST DEVICES

Take advantage of that CloudMe is one of the cloud storage services available on most types of devices. Example; iPhone, iPad, Android, Mac, Windows, Linux, GoogleTV, Samsung SmartTV, WD TV, Microsoft Storage Server, CloudTop, WebDAV, and web browsers.









HOW THE APPS WORK

In all our apps you will find Home, Synced, Shared, Following and Player. Through *Home* you search, have shortcuts to synced folders and can access the Cloud Drive. *Synced* gives you a list of all synced folders. Any folder on your computer or Cloud Drive may be set up as a sync folder. *Shared* contains all your shared folders. If you change contents in the folder you originally shared, the contents of the shared folder will also be updated. *Following* is a list of all shared folders you follow or WebShares as we call them. We do not reduce the size of your account when you follow a folder. Player allow you to view movies, music and also create playlists. Create a playlist on your phone, listen to it on your TV.
